(1 John 3:17)



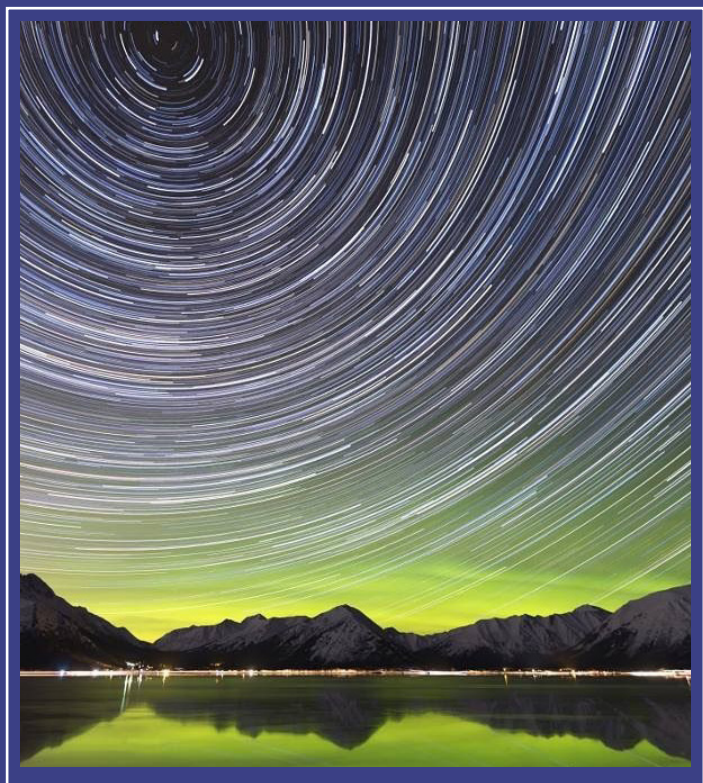


Keep your lives free from
